REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK — Oath Keeper

I Samuel 20:12-17

Jonathon, the son of King Saul recognized the anointing of God was upon David, saying; "thou shalt not cut off thy kindness from my house for ever: no, not when the Lord hath cut off the enemies of David every one from the face of the earth." (I Samuel 20:15). So, Jonathon made a covenant with the house of David saying; "Let the Lord even require it at the hand of David's enemies. And Jonathan caused David to swear again, because he loved him: for he loved him as he loved his own soul." (I Samuel 20:16b-17).

David hid himself and escaped from King Saul "when the new moon was come."

So after David became King, after the death of King Saul; David said, "Is there yet any that is left of the house of Saul, that I may shew him kindness for Jonathan's sake? And there was of the house of Saul a servant whose name was Ziba. And when they had called him unto David, the king said unto him, Art thou Ziba? And he said, Thy servant is he. And the king said, Is there not yet any of the house of Saul, that I may shew the kindness of God unto him? And Ziba said unto the king, Jonathan hath yet a son, which is lame on his feet. And the king said unto him, Where is he? And Ziba said unto the king, Behold, he is in the house of Machir, the son of Ammiel, in Lodebar." (2 Samuel 9:1-4).

After learning this, the King sent and fetched him out of the house of Machir, the son of Ammiel, from Lodebar.

REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK (CON'T)

David kept his oath to Jonathon, restored all the land of Saul, and invited Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, to eat at David's table continually. David called Ziba, Saul's servant, and conveyed to him all that pertained to Saul. Also, the servants shall till the land for him, that the son of Jonathon will have food to eat. Ziba said unto the King, all that my lord the King commanded, they shall do.

Because of David's oath unto Jonathon's son was able to dwell in Jerusalem, in his own house, with servants. Ziba the servant with his fifteen sons, and twenty servants, was also taken care of.

The scripture says, "I counsel thee to keep the king's commandment, and that in regard of the oath of God. Where the word of a king is, there is power: and who may say unto him, What doest thou?" (Ecclesiastes 8:2; 4).
